

down some distance and badly injured, but will probably recover. The houses on either side of the street were completely riddled. Numerous hair breadth escapes occurred. Most prominent was that of Mr. McGilheny and wife, living on the corner opposite the explosion. The windows and doors were blown to fragments, and a large piece of the driving wheel fell through the house on to the bed where they were sleeping. Their room is literally torn to pieces, and still they escaped without serious injury. The engine is a complete wreck not a fragment of the boiler being left near it. Large pieces were blown in every direction for four or five squares. Nothing definite can be ascertained as to the cause of the explosion.

Custis Lee, son of the famous Robert E. Lee, General Fitzhugh Lee, of Virginia; General W. H. F. Lee, Colonel Larkin Smith, of Georgia, Colonel L. B. Northrup, ex-Commissioner General of the Confederacy, Prof. M. F. Maury, of Lexington, Virginia, Captain Crooke, the inventor of the system of deep sea soundings which paved the way for laying the Atlantic cable; General H. R. Jackson, of Georgia, former Minister to Austria; and lastly General Wm. Preston of Kentucky, former Minister at Madrid.
