been no dividing line established for the
same. Now on motion, It is ordered by
the Board that said Township be divided
as follows to-wit:
On the Section line of said Township
running east and west through the center
of said Township, the same dividing
Sections 18 and 19, 21, 26, 16, 31, 14 and 24,
14 and 23, 13 and 24.
And that all persons living north of said
line shall vote at Smithville, which is the
North Precinct, and all living south of
said line shall vote at Harrodsburg, which
shall be the South Precinct, and that
Abraham C. Dowden be and is hereby ap
pointed Inspector of said North Precinct,
and said Order be printed in each of
the following papers, the Courier and
Program.
