—Our natural gas people are requested to hurry up the business so that the citizens of Bloomington may take advantage of Adrienne Hill, a resident of the town of Adrienne, who claims to have made a successful experiment in solidifying natural gas. He claims to be able to reduce it to the consistency of hard. In his first experiment he reduced 300 quarts of field gas to one quart, and claims that the condensed gas burned and heated an ordinary stove for twelve hours. He has great faith in the possibilities of the discovery and has applied for a patent. In its condensed form it can be sold much cheaper than oil, which is now used for fuel. He also says that it is safe to handle and that there is no danger whatever of explosion.

—A young man was accidentally shot by a ball from a Robert rifle at Adrienne, one day last week, and has since died. The use of Robert rifles by reckless and inexperienced boys and men, is becoming too common. The cartridge used in this rifle is composed of dynamite and powdered glass, and when it explodes produces blood poisoning and fatal results.

—Attorney General Michener, in answer to an inquiry as to the formation of new precincts under the new act introducing the Australian system, says that county commissioners cannot form new precincts until the June term, 1880, as the law does not go into effect until then.

—The English sparrow is garrulous, and, like all garrulous birds, eats insects only sparingly when pressed by hunger. Insects and flesh eating birds, as the crow, blue-jay, the black bird, swallows, hawks, etc., are always lean in flesh, whilst all the grain eaters are fat when well fed. The English sparrow is generally fat the year round, and is a delicious bird for the table. The restaurants of this city should understand this, and aid in the destruction of the pests.
