The Indianapolis Journal takes twelve counties at random and shows from the returns that the not Democratic loss in the recent election on Cleveland's vote is 2,942, while in the same counties the not Republican loss on Harrison's vote was 6,393. The proportion will hold good throughout the State, and will make the vote fall short from 75,000 to 80,000, and the Republicans loss will be three times the Democratic loss. This being true, it further shows that the Democratic victory is due to Republican stay-at-homes.

**Democrats and the Census.**  
Democrats are getting ready for a great fight upon the census. They have discovered what the figures mean from a political point of view. Just two-thirds of the increase of 12,000,000 in the Republican States. The basis of 18,000,000 for a Representative means a loss in the unrepresented fractional parts of service as much to Democratic States as it does to Republican States. Such unpleasant facts as these are gradually dawning upon Democratic comprehension. Fortunately, it does not require any great statistical array of figures to prove this fact. Figures may not lie, but they are the favorite instruments by which the falsifier produces his effects. But a man of middle life needs only to turn back the page of his own remembrance to recall a time when, in every little village, were to be found the thrifty independent representatives of almost every branch of manufacture. Waggonmakers, founders, timmitha, shoemakers, woollen mills, tanneries, were to be found all over the land. Now, these small establishments have almost all disappeared. The small tinsmith has become a repairer or roofer; the shoemaker has dwindled to a saleman or cobbler; the wagonmaker sets tires and replaces fenders; the small founder or machinist has become a doctor for broken-down engines. A few great pianos or a few great combinations of capital, manufacture all that is made. Considering both the population and the output, it is safe to say that there was ten times as large a proportion of employers in every line of manufacture forty years ago than there is to-day.
