Latest Returns from the Fall Elections—A Few More Ball Player Dead—Cremated While Slipping a Wound—Mexicans Alarmed at a Volcano Eruption.

The Election.

Returns received up to Friday noon shows the following result:

NEW YORK.

The total vote of the State on Governor—Governor, and Judge of the Court of Appeals, as follows:

For Governor—Morton, 670,501; Hill, 513,720; Wheeler, 28,635; Morton's plurality, 156,781.

For Lieutenant Governor—Saxton, 662,989; Lockwood, 537,164; Saxton's plurality, 125,825.

For Judge of the Court of Appeals—Haight, 653,941; Brown, 626,726; Haight's plurality, 127,515.

The official vote of New York city for mayor is as follows: William L. Strong, (Rep.) 1,043,043; Hugh J. Grant, (Tammany) 105,778; Lucien Sanial, (soc.) 7,181; James McTuliam, (Peo.) 288; George Gettlen, (Pro.) 36; Strong's plurality, 44,265. The uncertainty about the Board of Aldermen was removed by the elected members of the Board of Aldermen, 17 out of the 31 members. The Board will have the apportionment of the city for assembly districts.

KANSAS.

The latest figures at State political

elected seven Republican Congressmen

and one Populist, William Baker, in

Lynch in Georgia.

The neighbors of the injured woman were not satisfied, however, and took the negro from the jail and carried him to the outskirts of town and hanged him, riddling his body with bullets.

At Flint, Mich., Willie Grinnage, aged 10 years, burned his leg by a stove. He then got a piece of cloth and saturated it with kerosene oil, was binding it about his leg when he again got it so close to the stove. The cloth caught fire and the youth had his legs, arms, and chest burned to a crisp before the fire was extinguished.

Bid Wool Dealer Assigns.

P. H. Matthews, dealer in wool at 252 Congress street, Boston, has made an assignment. The liabilities are estimated at \$600,000, and the assets are said to consist of \$250,000 in pledges secured on wool, the equity in which is more than sufficient to sustain, to pay all matured indebtedness.

T. M. Latimer, an Allegheny, Pa., dry goods merchant, made an assignment for the benefit of his creditors. Judgments aggregating \$65,000 were confessed. The amount to be paid is \$100,000. Shrinking in value and inability to collect outstanding bills are the causes of the failure.
