

SYNOPSIS

Of the President's Proclamation, No. 640, dated the thirtieth day of May, 1859.

It orders Public Land sales in the State of Iowa, to be held at the time and places stated as follows:

At the Land Office, Fort Dodge, commencing on MONDAY, THE THIRD DAY OF SEPTEMBER, the disposal of the Public Lands heretofore unoffered of FORTY-ONE TOWNSHIPS and parts of townships, situated in the northwestern part of said State, in the counties of Humboldt, Wright, Buena Vista, and Franklin, Iowa.

At the Land Office at Sioux City, commencing on MONDAY, THE THIRD DAY OF OCTOBER next, for the disposal of the public lands herefore unoffered, situated in the counties of Fremont, Otoe, and O'Brien, Omaha, Cass, Burt, and Plymouth, THIRTY-ONE TOWNSHIPS and parts of townships.

Lands appropriated by law for the use of schools, Military and other purposes, together with the unappropriated lands, will be excluded from the sales.

The sales will be kept open until the lands all offered, which is estimated within two weeks, and no sale, and no private entry of any of the same, will be permitted until after the expiration of the two weeks.

Pre-emption claimants are required to establish their claims to the satisfaction of the proper commissioners, and to pay the amount due for the same on or before the day appointed for the commencement of the public sales, otherwise their claim will be forfeited.
