AN ORDINANCE,

Relative to Peddlers and Hawkers.

Sec. 1. Be it ordained by the Mayor and common
council of the City of Crawfordsville, That, it shall
hereafter be unlawful for any street Peddler, hawk-
er or other itinerant, retail or wholesale dealer in
goods, wares or merchandise, to offer the same for
sale in wagons, carriages, or otherwise, within said
city, without having obtained license for that pur-
pose.

Sec. 2. No license shall be issued for a less period
than two days, nor a greater period than one year,
and all licenses shall be registered by the clerk.

Sec. 3. It shall be the duty of the city clerk to
make out all licenses granted to peddlers and hawk-
ers, and issue the same on receiving from the appli-
cant the license fee of the Mayor, and the city treasurer's
receipt for twenty dollars for a license running one
year, and for any less period, a sum at the discretion
of the Mayor.

Sec. 4. Every hawker, peddler, or other person
going about or through the city, either on foot, or
with horse, or otherwise carrying to sell, or expos-
ing for sale, any goods, wares or merchandise with-
out license, upon conviction thereof before the Mayor,
shall be punished by a fine in any sum not less than
one dollar, nor more than fifty dollars.

Sec. 5. If any such hawker, peddler, or other per-
son as aforesaid, shall refuse to show his, her, or their
license, when requested by any person or persons, who
she, or they shall offer to sell any of his, her, or their
goods, wares or merchandise, or to the Marshal of
the city, or his deputies, shall be punished in the same
manner as for exposing the same for sale with-
out license.

Sec. 6. Nothing in this Ordinance contained, shall
be construed to apply to the vendors of vegetables,
or other articles of food; provided, also, competent
distributing reliefs, local, or transitory, shall be
excepted.

Sec. 7. This Ordinance shall be enforced from
and after its legal publication.

AN ORDINANCE,

In Relation to Theatres, Shows, &c.

Sec. 1. Be it ordained by the Mayor and Com-
mon Council of the City of Crawfordsville, that any
person or persons, who shall exhibit, or participate
in exhibiting, for gain or profit, in the City of Cra-
wfordsville, any theatrical performance of any kind
or description, any shows or puppets, wax-figures,
menagerie, caravan or collection of animals, any
performance of any feats of tumbling, rope or wire
dancing, balancing, sleight of hand, or tricks of leg-
domaine, or any circus, of natural or artificial curi-
osity, or deception, or representation of any kind
whatsoever, or any other exhibition or public show,
for which compensation or money is charged or de-
manded, except lectures on science, history, litera-
ture, or literary subjects, and the apparatus for the
elucidation of the same, and specimens of the fine
arts, without license therefor, made out, tested,
signed and sealed, shall, for each offense, con-
viction thereof before the Mayor, forfeit and pay any
sum not exceeding fifty dollars and the costs.

Sec. 2. The Mayor of the City is hereby authorized
to grant license for the exhibition of public shows as
aforesaid, of any menagerie, caravan, or collection of
animals or circus, on the payment into the city treas-
ury of the sum of twenty dollars for each day's ex-
hibition or performance, and for all other shows or ex-
hibitions above enumerated for each day's exhibi-
tion or performance, not less than two nor more than
twenty dollars, to be fixed and determined in the dis-
cretion of the Mayor.

Sec. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect, and be
enforced from and after its legal and legal publication.
Passed September 25th, 1865.

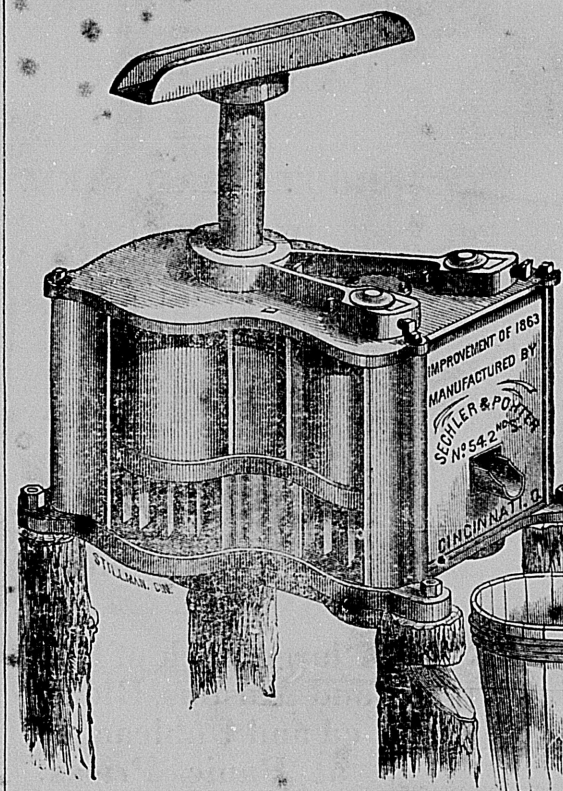
