APPLICATION FOR LIQUOR LICENSE.
Notice is hereby given to the citizens of Union township, Montgomery county, Indiana, that I, John H. Bannister, the undersigned, a white male inhabitant of the State of Indiana, and now and for more than ninety (90) days' time prior to the date of this notice of application, a continuous resident of said township, and for more than ninety (90) days' time prior to the date of application hereof, a continuous resident of said township, County and State, and over the age of twenty-one (21) years, and fit person to be intrusted with a license to sell intoxicating liquors, will apply at the regular June session, 1897, of the Board of Commissioners of said county, commencing on the first Monday of said month, for a license to sell all kinds of spirituous, vinous, malt and other intoxicating liquors in a less quantity than a quart, and allow the same to be drunk on the premises where sold.
My place of business and the premises whereon and wherein said liquors are to be sold and drunk are situated and specifically described as follows: A part of the east half of the south-east quarter of section thirty (30), in township nineteen (19) north, of range four (4) west, in Montgomery county, Indiana, and described by metes and bounds as follows, to-wit: Commencing for a beginning point, three hundred and three (303) feet and nine (9) inches east of a point on the west line of said east half one hundred and seventy (170) feet and six (6) inches west of the north-west corner of said east half, said distance of 1,705 feet is measured on the west line of said east half from said north-west corner running thence south thirty-seven and one-half (37 1/2) degrees, east eighteen (18) feet and three (3) inches; thence north fifty-two and one-half (52 1/2) degrees, east forty-two (42) feet and four (4) inches; thence north thirty-seven and one-half (37 1/2) degrees; thence south fifty-two and one-half (52 1/2) degrees; west forty-two (42) feet and four (4) inches to the place of beginning, in the only front and ground room, of only two-story frame building situated on said premises, the dimensions of said room being seventeen (17) feet and three (3) inches wide, fourteen (14) feet and six (6) inches deep, and ten (10) feet from floor to ceiling, with window two (2) feet and six (6) inches wide and six (6) feet and eight (8) inches high, and about four (4) feet from the ground; said window, room and premises fronting on the public highway running in a northerly direction from the city of Crawfordsville, in said county, and known as the Lafayette pike.
