HE HAS A GREAT HORSE

W. H. Stultz Owns Harley Artell, One of the Best.

The Western Horseman recently published the record and breeding of his new purchase, Harley Artell, and we republish it for the benefit of the many who will be interested.

Harley Artell 4222.

As stated in this paper some weeks ago, W. H. Stultz, of Decatur, Ind., possessed himself of a wonderfully high-class young trotting stallion when he purchased Harley Artell 4222. Speaking of this really bred youngster, W. P. Dunn, Terre Haute, for years the owner of Artell (79) 2-12 says: "Since the death of Artell, who produced many prominent sons, I know of very few that are the equal in point of size and conformation to the young stallion Harley Artell, recently purchased by W. H. Stultz, of Decatur, Ind., from Edgar Miller, of Terre Haute, and I think under any possible circumstances he will make a high-class sire." Harley Artell 4222, as intimated, is a son of Artell, who held the world's record for a three-year-old to high wheel milky, and was one of the most sensational race stallions of his day. As a progenitor he is now the sire of 122 standard performers, seven of these with records of 2:10 or better, and nearly all of them trotters, while his daughters have produced thirty-seven standard performers, including five with records of 2:08 1/2 and better, while about thirty of his sons are now the sires of close to 200 standard performers, including some of the most sensational race horses of the day, among which might be mentioned Hamburg Melle, 2:04 1/2; Antipoll, 2:04 1/2; Gen. Wards (3) 2:04 1/2; Tom Arworthy, 2:07; Guy Arworthy (4) 2:04 1/2, and others. Harley Artell's dam was Playmate J., record 2:29 1/2, and much faster; she by Jersey Wilkes, sire of 60 standard performers, including three in the 2:10 list, and the dams of forty, including Home Circle, 2:07, thus making Harley Artell a blood brother to that good trotter. His second dam was Helpmate, dam of Helmar, 2:15 1/2, a great brood mare by that son race horse Wedgewood, 2:19, who sired the dam of John R. Gentry, 2:00 1/2, and others of that ilk. She in turn was out of Lady Foney, record 2:14 1/2, dam of Miss Foney, 2:22 1/2; Foxwood, 2:14 1/2, sire of three in 2:10, etc. She by Daniel Lambert, the greatest and the handsomest of the Morgans, out of that grand old Morgan brood mare, old Foney, showing a combination of blood lines that would be hard to duplicate within the life of the stud book. Harley Artell is a handsome brown stallion of magnificent size and conformation, standing 14 1/2 hands high and weighing 1,300 pounds. He was given a limited amount of training, and started in but two races, both of which he won in straight heats, taking a record of 2:24 1/2 at Terre Haute, and afterward trotting a trial mile in 2:11 1/2, with a last half in 1:04, and this as a four-year-old. Taking his magnificent blood line, his great individuality and his known speed ability into consideration, the breeders of Indiana are fortunate in having so great a stallion, by the mighty Artell so accessible, as we understand it is Mr. Stultz's intention to place him in the stud at Decatur.
