A STATE SESSION

Drs. Keller and Miller Attend State Meeting of the Health Officers

CITY AND COUNTY

Program Includes Lectures by Famous Men from Over the Country

Dr. H. E. Keller, the city health officer, and Dr. J. M. Miller secretary of the county board, went to Indianapolis today, where they will attend a three days' session of the city and county boards of health of Indiana, which convenes at the Claypool hotel tomorrow, and will continue during Thursday and Friday. These meetings are always of great interest and many things of interest are brought up, which if executed by the health officers, greatly aids the public. The program includes lectures by the best known health men of the land, several men of reputation from the east being on the card this year, and it is assured that those who attend will obtain many valuable pointers in the way of protecting and caring for the health of the citizens of the community. Both Drs. Keller and Miller have served in the capacity they now fill for a number of years, and are well versed in the laws of the state. Both are likewise progressive and this opportunity to hear lectures on the subjects of so much interest will be appreciated by the doctors.
