PETITION FOR MACADAM ROAD.

State of Indiana, County of Adams, ss: Before the Board of Commissioners Adams County, November Term, 1914.

We, the undersigned, each and all of whom are residents, adult freeholders and voters of Washington and Kirkland Townships in Adams County, Indiana petition your Honorable Body that you construct and complete a free macadam stone road in said townships, over and upon a public highway situated on the following route, to-wit:

Commencing at the northeast corner of section one (1) in township twenty-seven (27) north, range thirteen (13) east, in Adams County, Indiana, running thence south upon the public highway dividing section one (1) in said township twenty-seven (27) north, range thirteen (13) east, and section six (6) in township twenty-seven (27) north, range fourteen (14) east, and terminating at the southwest corner of said section six (6) and between said townships as aforesaid.

Said petitioners say that the improvement prayed for is less than three (3) miles in length and connects at both ends with a free macadam road in said townships.

Your petitioners further aver and say that the highway herein sought to be improved is a public highway already established and in use and is one of the public highways between said townships of Washington and Kirkland.

Your petitioners ask your honorable body that said highway above described be drained and graded and that broken stone be placed upon the grade and upon such broken stone there be placed stone screenings, and that this improvement be made exclusive of crushed stone screenings.

Your petitioners further ask that said highway above described be improved to the width of forty (40) feet, and said highway above described be graded to the width of twenty-four (24) feet, and that broken stone be placed to the width of ten (10) inches in the center and six (6) inches at the sides thereof, and that crushed stone screenings be placed thereon to a depth of four (4) inches upon such broken stone, and that this improvement be made exclusive of crushed stone screenings.

PETITION FOR MACADAM ROAD.

State of Indiana, County of Adams, ss: Before the Board of Commissioners Adams County, November Term, 1914.

We, the undersigned, each and all of whom are residents, adult freeholders and voters of French Township, in Adams County, Indiana, petition your Honorable Body that you construct and complete a free macadam stone road in said township, over and upon a public highway situated on the following route, to-wit:

Commencing at the northwest corner of section twenty-three (23), township twenty-six (26) north, range thirteen (13) east, in Adams County, Indiana, thence running east on the section line road between sections fourteen (14) on the north and twenty-three (23) on the south to the northeast corner of said section twenty-three (23) and there to terminate. All of said route being in French Township, Adams County, Indiana.

Your petitioners aver and say that the improvement prayed for is less than three miles in length, connects at both ends with a free macadam road in said township, and that a United States Rural Mail Route passes over the said highway sought to be improved.

Your petitioners aver and say that the highway herein sought to be improved is a public highway already established and in use, and is one of the public highways of said French township, and that the same will be of public utility and benefit.

Your petitioners ask that the said highway herein sought to be improved be drained and graded and that the said improvement be made upon the said road as it is now located.

Your petitioners further ask that the said highway be improved to the width it now is, being about forty feet and that the same be graded to a width of twenty-four feet and that crushed stone be placed thereon to a width of ten feet and to a depth of six inches at the sides thereof, and eight inches in the center thereof, that stone screenings be placed thereon to a proper depth; that said road be made a double track and that the name of the same be "The Siegrist Macadam Road."

That to pay for such improvements we ask that bonds be issued by the County of Adams in the State of Indiana, payable in twenty (20) semi-annual installments or series, and for the payment of which we ask that a tax be levied upon the taxable property of said French Township, in a sufficient amount to pay the interest and principal of said bonds, as they become due.

That said improvement be made and constructed and that said bonds be issued and said tax be levied upon the taxable property of said Township, in accordance with the Acts of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana as passed in the year 1905 and as amended by the Acts of 1907 and the Act of 1909, now in force, providing for the extension of free gravel or macadam roads and any and all other amendments thereto.

We further ask the board to take all the necessary steps as required by law to have said improvement constructed without submitting the question of building it, to an election of the voters of said Washington and Kirkland townships and that the Board construct the same under the laws of the State of Indiana, under the laws of the State of Indiana, providing for the extension of free gravel and macadam roads and any and all other amendments thereto.
