Oh the pang of that mother, who after a life of street adding and gossip sees her children tossed out on the sea of life like foam on the wave or nonentities in a world only bravery and stalwart character can stand the shock.

Last Nights Sermon.

Text—Job 2:4, "All that a man has will he give for life."

After a few minutes introductory, Rev. Honeywell said:-

We are weighted in the gospel balances. I will tell you what they are. They are the ten commandments.

First commandment: "Thou shalt have no gods before me?"

What is a man's God? A man's God is the one thing he thinks of most. If a man thinks more of money than anything else, money is his God; and many a man here tonight is worshipping the god of wealth.

Many a man is sacrificing conscience, sacrificing honor, sacrificing obedience to God to gain money. There are men who worship gold to-day just as truly as though they made a golden calf and knelt and prayed to it.

Isacriot Better.

You society people betray Christ to his enemies and then for a pretense of His love give a charity ball. I would rather be Jusas Isacriot; he had less light.

Society, the heartless wretch; society, the leech of the soul; when it comes to a choice of pleasing God or pleasing society, many will slap God in the face and turn and please society. Society is their God.

Many a man worships whiskey. How many a man is sacrificing his brain power, his business ability, their respect of his fellow citizens, the reverence and love of his wife and children in devotion to the cursed whiskey.

The second commandment is so closely allied with the first I shall pass it by.

The third commandment deals with profanity. We are the most profane nation in the world. A mother can't send her little boy down the street without some wretch sowing the seed of profanity in his heart.

Sabbath Desecration. Sabbath observance has been the bulwark of our national strength. I am against any ordinance of any man or any band of men that allow or encourage any violation of the Sabbath day.

If you find me a man who keeps the Sabbath day holy, I will show you a man who will keep every other day of the week holy. Show me the man who will desecrate the Sabbath and I

will show you the man who will desecrate every other day of the week.

Fifth commandment, "Honor thy father and thy mother, etc."

We are getting into the day when the young think they know more than their parents, speaking lightly about "the old man and old woman." They think father and mother old fogies and that they know it all and that when they die wisdom will die, too.

Show me the young man who speaks slightly of father and mother and I will show you a fellow doomed to failure and defeat. Show me the young girl who is ashamed of her mother and disobeys her and I will show you a girl who will never amount to much. Show me the boy or girl who respect and honor father and love mother and I will show those with success gleaming out before them.

Many Ways Of Killing.

The sixth commandment says: "Thou shalt not kill." You may say you are all right on this commandment that there are no murderers here, that it might be all right to preach on such a commandment to an audience in the slums of Chicago, but wide of the mark in a law-abiding town like this.

There are many other ways of killing besides driving a dagger into the heart or firing a bullet into the brain. Many a husband is killing his wife by neglect, cruelty and unfaithfulness.

Many a woman is hastening to her grave with a broken heart because she has learned that the man who swore to be true to her is unfaithful to his vow.

There are many mothers sleeping in your graveyard tonight killed by ungrateful sons.

If there is any hand in the world that is scarlet with the blood of murder, it is that of a woman who murders her unborn babe; and there are many men who call themselves physicians who will act as helpers in the hellish business. We call them M. D. I would call them D. M.—Damnable Murderers. Every one of them should be strung up.

I cannot discuss before a mixed audience the seventh commandment about adultery. I have enough sense to know that; but this sin is blighting our nation and the judgments of God are on your track. The woman untrue to her husband, and the man untrue to his wife, the curse of God is sure to follow.

What is it to steal? To steal is to take property from another without giving adequate equivalent in either property or money in return.
