THE KIND OF MEN

That Make a Conquering
Church Will be Discuss-
ed by Mr. Gerhardt

LUTHERAN CHURCHES

Of Northern Indiana Will
Boost Work of Brother-
hood Organizations

On Wednesday, July 7, Mr. H. B. Gerhardt, field secretary of the Lutheran Brotherhood of the United Lutheran church will be in Fort Wayne in order to develop the brotherhood activities and organizations within the United Lutheran church.

Mr. Gerhardt will meet with delegations of men from every church in this territory. He will address a group meeting on "The Kind of Men that Make a Conquering Church." A round-table will follow on practical brotherhood work and local chapters will be formed where none exist now. The Lutheran Brotherhood is working with the slogan "A Lutheran Brotherhood in every pastorate of the United Lutheran church doing worth-while things."

During the past months the brotherhood has been extensively broadening its organization. Its field secretary spent some weeks through the southeastern states, organizing nearly 100 local chapters and the effect upon

church life, it is said, was remarkable. On the present trip the field secretary is covering the states of Ohio, Indiana, Michigan, and Kentucky whose total Lutheran membership approximates one-quarter million.

The national headquarters of the Lutheran Brotherhood are in Chicago. Dr. S. S. Waltz, for many years pastor in Louisville, and the father of the brotherhood organization, is the general secretary. The general officers are: President, Hon. John L. Zimmerman of Springfield, Ohio; vice presidents, Mr. E. Clarence Miller, of Philadelphia, Mr. Chas. J. Dreier of Chicago, and Mr. Philip Weltner of Atlanta; recording secretary, Mr. J. W. Kahler of Cincinnati; corresponding secretary, Mr. H. B. Gerhardt of Chicago; treasurer, Harry T. Demer, Esq. of Washington. The object of the brotherhood is to mobilize the men of the church for service to the church, the community, and the country.

Among those locally interested are Reverend C. W. Diederich, H. C. Hadley, J. W. Miller, and S. Wagenhals, D. D.

Delegations will attend from Monroeville, Columbia City, Uniondale, Hoagland, Rock Creek, Huntington, and Decatur.
