ON JUDGING TEAM

Paul Blackburn, This City, One of Four Purdue Men to Receive the Honor

GOES TO CHICAGO

To Attend National Dairy Show—Work of All Students of Class Praised

G. J. Brown, of Milford, a junior; Paul Blackburn, of Decatur, a junior; W. J. Poe, of Rockville, a senior, and R. B. Oyler, of Warsaw, a senior, as alternate, will compose the team which will represent Purdue University in the intercollegiate dairy products judging team at the National Dairy Show at Chicago October 7 to 18th. This was the announcement made last night by Prof. F. D. Lucas of the Dairy department, who has been coaching the twelve agricultural students who have been competing for the team. The work of all the students was excellent, he said, and it was only after most careful calculations of all the grades that he was able to select the team.

Attend Show October 7.

The team will leave for the dairy show October 7th, and will spend several days judging market milk, cheese and butter, not only at the show, but also at Chicago commission houses. Expenses up to \$15 are being paid for each of the four men by the Indiana Dairy Manufacturers' association, and in addition the association will give the member of the team scoring the highest a cash prize of \$15; \$10 to the second man and \$5 to the third.

The dairy cattle judging team which has been coached by Prof. L. H. Fairchild will leave Sunday on a trip to Wisconsin to judge dairy cattle for a few days before entering the competition at Chicago.—Purdue Exponent.

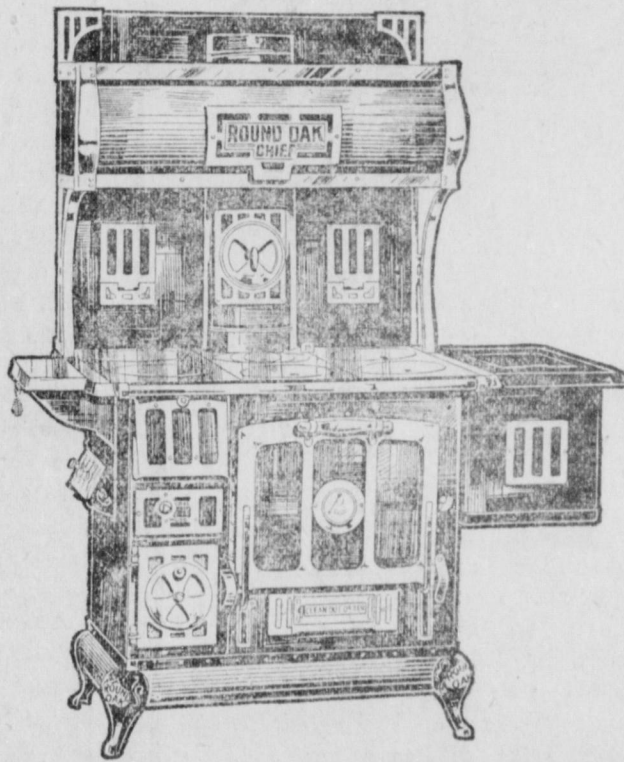
