



THE SUGAR FACTORY

Needs Co-operation of People of the Community and Should Have it Now

For two months now, almost the entire of people in this section of the country has centered upon the election and for the next few days the results will be the main topic, and then what? The Decatur Industrial association has been loafing on the job along with the rest of the societies for better conditions and as a consequence there are many things to be attended to. One of the most important of these is that the organizations co-operate with the Holland-St. Louis sugar factory and assist them in continuing operation here.

FIFTEENTH TIME

Uncle "Billy" Blackburn Cast His Ballot for the Democratic Nominees

WIFE VOTED WITH HIM

Appeared at "A" Precinct, Second Ward at 8:30 and "Voted 'er Straight"

Uncle "Billy" Blackburn, accompanied by his faithful companion, entered the voting booth at the court house in "A" precinct of the second ward at 8:30 o'clock this morning, and for the fifteenth time in his life cast his ballot for the democratic candidate for president of the United States, and all other democratic candidates. Of course Mrs. Blackburn voted for Mr. Cox for president and all the rest of the candidates down to advisory board members.

Uncle "Billy," as every one knows him here, was exceedingly happy that he was again permitted to cast his ballot, and also that Mrs. Blackburn could accompany him to the polls at this time, and vote for the principles in which he has believed and for which he has fought these many years.

His first vote was cast in 1860 for Stephen A. Douglas and his ballot has been cast in this city at every election since. He is now eighty-four years old, and Mrs. Blackburn was seventy-five last January 4. They are probably the oldest couple in the city to vote at the election here today.

During the past few months Mr. Blackburn has been quite sick and for many weeks was unable to come up town. During the last several weeks, however, his condition has been greatly improved, and he has visited almost daily with his friends up town. During the months that he was kept at home, however, he has read considerably, and has been greatly interested in political affairs of his county, and there is probably no voter who better understands the issues and the problems that Uncle "Billy" Blackburn.
