Science, however, has come to the aid of this rainless section of the country in the form of an ingenious desert waterworks, consisting of a series of frames containing 20,000 square feet of glass. The panes of glass are arranged in the shape of a V, and under each pane is a shallow pan containing brackish water. The heat of the sun evaporates the water, which condenses upon the sloping glass, and, made pure by this operation, it runs down in little channels at the bottom of the V and is carried away into the main canal. Nearly 1,000 gallons of fresh water is collected daily by this means.

"Chocolate Pop-Corn Balls"
4 ounces sweet chocolate, 2 cups sugar, 1 cup water, 1 teaspoonful salt, Pop-Corn.
Boil together the water, sugar and cream of tartar, until it forms a ball when dropped in cold water. Add the vanilla to the syrup. Pour part of this syrup over some of the popped-corn, stirring so the remaining syrup warm on the back of the range while shaping the corn into small balls.
Now boil us the remaining syrup until it spins a thread.
Dip each ball in this and place on paraffine paper to cool. Melt the chocolate and dip the cooled pop-corn balls into this while it is still warm.
