COW TEST ASSOCIATION POINTS WAY TO IMPROVEMENT OF DAIRY BUSINESS

The value of cow testing work is clearly shown in the report of the first year's testing by the Franklin County Association, where Miss Irma Bruce, the only girl tester in the state, was at work.

During the year, there were 17 herds in the association, with a total of 194 cows, 64 of which were pure-breds, all of the Jersey breed. At the start of the year, 12 of the members owned pure-bred sires and during the year, three more, realizing the value of pure-bred animals to head their herds, purchased pedigreed sires. Two of the association members dropped out, so the organization was left with every member owning a pure-bred sire.

Fourteen of the 17 members owned 18 silos at the start of the year and at the close every man had one or more silos, those who had not adopted silage as a basis for their ration, coming to this approved method of feeding. Seven members of the association weighed their milk daily and by thus "holding the stop watch on Bossy," they could tell which cows were profitable and which lost money for them. Seventeen cows were sold because their owners found through this method that they were unprofitable.

The best individual monthly record of the year was made by Jolly Letty, a pure-bred Jersey owned by J. A. Driscoll. She produced 1395 pounds of milk and 85.1 pounds of butterfat during July, leading the entire state that month. W. H. Senour, one of the association members was the only one to earn a membership in the 300 pound cow club, which comes by virtue of his having 10 or more cows producing 300 pounds or more of butterfat in a year.

The cow testing association members are active in the pure-bred sire campaign being waged in the south-eastern part of the state and because of their work have found out the importance of breeding better stock to have high producing cows.

Stunt to Cure Hiccoughs.

A Spanish physician claims to have been very successful in curing stubborn cases of hiccoughs by this treatment: The patient lies down and draws up his knees until his thighs are pressed tightly to his abdomen, the lower part of the legs being pressed against the thighs by bending the knees. The position is held for several minutes. The effect of this is to press the abdominal organs up against the diaphragm and to sustain the pressure until the diaphragm ceases its spasmodic contraction.

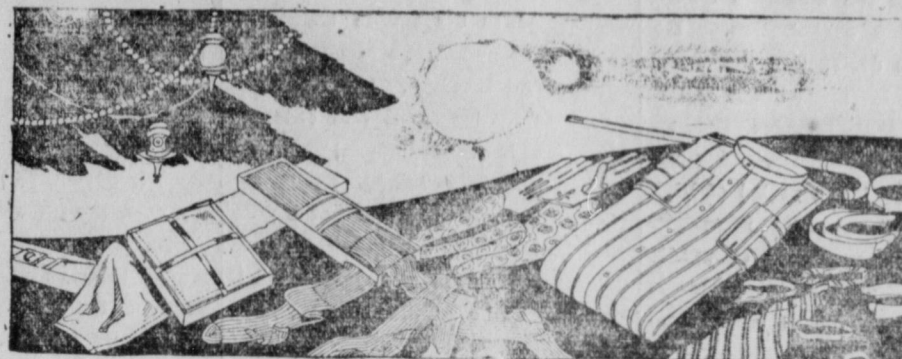
