

## THE RESTRICTIONS HAVE BEEN LIFTED

Ford Agents Are Now Permitted to Sell Popular Cars in Any Locality

## FIGHT FOR BUSINESS

Local Sales Agency Will Do Their Part to Sell Cars and Please the Public

The announcement from the Ford Motor car company at Detroit removing all territorial restrictions from their various agencies over the country was made public today, although the order was received at every point over this section last Friday afternoon in a circular letter sent to every dealer.

For years the Ford company has protected dealers by confining them to certain territory, and if the dealer encroached on the other man's territory, the agent making the sale was compelled to give up his commission, and was also given a black mark on the books of the company, and as a result very few sales were made in the other man's territory, or even attempted.

The local agents, Messrs. Shanahan and Conroy, announced today that they will make every effort to get all the business in the territory surrounding Decatur. At the same time they also want the owners and purchasers of Ford cars to know that service will be their slogan, and to every man, woman, or firm, which gives them an order for a car will be given the same courteous treatment, the locality making no difference to them. Of course the local dealers want all the business they can get, but at the same time believe that if the public is given the right kind of treatment, that in future months the public is given the right kind of business will come, by leaps and bounds, and first of all they desire to give the Ford owners service.

Up until last Friday Messrs. Shanahan and Conroy were permitted only to sell cars in the five north townships of the county, excepting a strip a mile in width across the entire county.


