HEAVY HAULING

It shall be unlawful for any person to haul over any turnpike, macadam or gravel road (the term "gravel road" to include any road graded and gravelled with not less than one yard of gravel to eight feet in width and nine feet in length of such road) at any time when the road is thawing through or by reason of wet weather is in condition to be cut up and injured by heavy hauling, a load on any vehicle with tires of less than three inches in width, the combined weight of which load and vehicle, including the driver, shall be more than twenty-five hundred pounds; or on any vehicle with tires of three inches and less than four inches in width, the combined weight of which load, vehicle and driver, shall be more than three thousand pounds; or any vehicle with tires of four inches and less than five inches in width, the combined weight of which load, vehicle and driver, shall be more than thirty-five hundred pounds; or on any vehicle with tires five inches or over in width, the combined weight of which load, vehicle and driver shall be more than thirty-eight hundred pounds. Any person violating any provision of this section shall, on conviction, be fined not less than five dollars nor more than fifty dollars for each load so hauled. This includes traction engines weighing over the above limit.

Provided, That any road superintendent shall have police power to arrest upon sight any person who is seen violating or by warrant any person who has violated any of the provisions of this section within the county or township for which such road superintendent is elected or appointed, and that, on conviction of the defendant in such cause, there shall be assessed by the court trying the cause a fee of two dollars in each case, to be paid to the person making such arrest.—Acts 907, Chapter 234.

The above law relative to traffic, on our highways you will notice bars any load of which the wagon or truck and load weighs over four thousand pounds, (4,000 lbs.), no use to ask about the tire width, we want you to help, when the roads are by reason of wet weather or freezing and thawing, are soft and easily rutted. Ton trucks will be permitted, when not hauling over a ton load, same rule will apply with a wagon, ton load permissible.

WOULD REGAIN LOST GROUND

Indiana and Purdue Universities Will Ask Coming Session of Legislature

FOR INCREASED LEVY Many Hoosier Young Men and Women Attending Schools Out of the State

Bloomington, Ind., Dec. 14. — The committee of the state universities and normal schools in Indiana has completed a survey showing that 1,065 Hoosier young men and women are seeking their university training in state-supported universities of the states surrounding Indiana. In Illinois, Michigan, Wisconsin, Ohio and Minnesota where these Indiana students have been attracted to the state universities of those states the educational crisis has been met by more liberal public aid to the institutions of higher learning. From these five states Indiana university has enrolled only 32 students while Purdue has 193 students from these states.

In Illinois university there are 450 Indiana students while five years ago the number was only 199. There are now 332 Hoosier students attending the University of Michigan, 174 at Wisconsin University, 97 at Ohio State University and nine at the University of Minnesota. Only a small percentage of Indiana students were attending these universities five years ago. The increased attendance of Indiana students at these five surrounding state-supported universities parallels the increased public support of these universities.

Some of the best men of the faculties of Indiana and Purdue university have gone to these five state universities call for about \$3,000,000 beginning in 1922 to enable them to regain the ground lost during the past years because of insufficient state aid. The two universities will ask the coming state legislature to authorize a levy sufficient to maintain and operate the universities in keeping with the forward step in higher education.

SON AND DAUGHTER SHARE LONGSHORE ESTATE

The Bluffton News prints the following concerning the disposition of the estate of the late Ira Longshore, father of Richard Longshore, well known here:

"The will of the late Ira Longshore was filed for probate today.

"He bequeaths to a son, Richard Longshore, a farm of 85 acres, and to a daughter, Zepha Smith, a farm of 49 acres.

"To the daughter also is bequeathed \$5,000 to be paid out of personal property, and if there is insufficient personal property the balance of the \$5,000 is to be paid by the son, Richard, any such balance, if any, to stand as a lien against the 85-acre farm until paid.

"Any residue after above legacies is to be divided equally between the

brother and sister. "The son is to act as executor of the will."


