## WORK ON BRIDGE

Will be Rushed as Soon as Contractor is Satisfied Weather is Settled

## THE FLOOR REMAINS

To be Built and Fill Made at South End—North Fill is Completed

Work on the north bridge over the St. Mary's river will soon be completed, that is if the contractor and superintendent are satisfied that the weather man will not dish up any freezing weather which would prevent the laying of the concrete floor. A creosote block floor is to be put on top of the concrete, which makes one of the finest floors for bridge construction.

Road Superintendent Hendricks has completed the fill at the north end of the structure, and work will be started on the south fill as soon as the construction company removes their material and paraphernalia from the roadbed, so that the teams and men of the highway department

5½ cups Granulated Sugar 3 cups Cream  
2 cups Karo (Green Label)  
A few drops Maple Flavoring

Boil until the mixture forms a ball when tried in cold water. Put the pan into a pan of cold water. If you wish, add one pound nut meats. When cool beat with a cake spoon until the candy is creamy. Pour into a loaf pan lined with oiled paper.

NOTE: The candy is hard to "beat" at first, on account of the syrup, but after a little beating the mixture becomes thin and is easy to beat. When it begins to get hard again, pour into the pan. If desired, fruit may be added as follows:

1 small box of Candied Cherries  
1 slice of Candied Pineapple  
¼ pound Almonds
