PETITION FOR A ROAD IMPROVEMENT

State of Indiana, Adams County, ss: Before the Board of Commissioners of Adams County, Indiana.

We, the undersigned each and all of whom are adult, resident freeholders and voters of Monroe township, Adams county, Indiana, respectfully petition your honorable body and ask that you construct and complete for the extension of free gravel or macadam roads by township taxation.

Commencing at the Township line between Hartford and Wabash townships at the northwest corner of section twenty-six (26), township twenty-six (26) north, of range fourteen (14) east, in Adams county, Indiana, thence running north, following the public highway through the center of said highway twenty-six (26) aforesaid, and terminating at the northwest corner of said section twenty-six (26) aforesaid.

Your petitioners aver and say that the improvement prayed for is less than three miles in length, connects with the State Line in Sections thirty (30) and Township twenty-five (25) north of Range fourteen (14) east.

Commencing at the northwest corner of section twenty-nine (29) in the Town of Geneva in said Township, thence northward through rural roads passes over said highway and the same will be of public utility and benefit.

Your petitioners further aver and say that the highway herein sought to be improved is a public highway already established and in use, that there is a large amount of public travel thereon and the same is one of the public highways of Wabash township.

Your petitioners ask that said highway above described be drained and graded and that broken stone be placed in the grade and the upon such broken stone there be placed stone screenings.

Your petitioners further ask that said highway above described be improved and graded to a width of 40 feet, and that said highway above described be placed thereon to a width of 10 feet and the depth of 6 inches in the center thereof, and that crushed stone screenings be placed thereon to a depth of 10 inches in the center thereof, and that the name of the same be "The William L. Ray Macadam Road."
