

CABLEGRAMS CHEAPER

Western Union Office Notified of Drop in Rate

The local branch of the Western Union Telegraph Company has received announcement of new rates on cablegram messages between the United States and some of the foreign countries.

The rates to Great Britain and France has been reduced from 31c to 28c a word. The deferred rate on the message which is filed and sent at the will of the manager is 14 cents; Germany the rate was 36c and now 32c, the deferred rate is 16½c; to

Greece, rate was 43c, now 41c, the deferred rate, 20½c; to Italy, was 37c, now 34c, the deferred rate is 17c.

ASK AID OF SPORTSMEN

Statistics on Geese and Ducks Wanted by Conservation Dept.

The United States biological survey has asked Indiana sportsmen and citizens to help gather statistics regarding the mating and breeding of wild ducks and geese in this state, and to this end is sending out through the state conservation department, blank questionnaires. Sportsmen and others are being asked to provide the data.

"Several hundred similar blanks were mailed to Indiana last year with hardly any returns. This was very disappointing because we know there were some wild ducks bred and reared in this state in 1922 and will be again this year," George N. Mannfield, chief of the fish and game division, said.

The biological station wishes such data as: Exact location of breeding grounds and name of birds, ducks and geese; dates when seen mating, dates when seen in mated pairs, dates of nests found without eggs, dates of nests found with egg or eggs, dates of nests found with young and dates of downy young found out of nest.

According to conservation officials, members of 160 organized fish and game protective associations of this state will be asked to assist in providing the government with desired data.

Woman Is Hanged for Murder in Canada Today

Fort Saskatchewan, Alberta, May 2.—(Special to Daily Democrat)—Florence Lassandra, the first woman hanged in Canada in 24 years and one of the few ever hanged on the North America continent, went to her death on the gallows here today. Her hanging followed that of Emil Picarillo, who was hanged at 5:15 a.m.—approximately half an hour be-

fore Mrs. Lassandra.

The two had been convicted of the murder of Constable Lawson of Crows Nest Pass, Alberta.

Before the trap was sprung, Mrs.

Lassandra confessed that she had fired the first of the shots which killed Lawson.

The same gallows were used for both executions.
