New York, Jan. 16.—Plans for the organization of a tournament to find the successor to Benny Leonard, world's lightweight champion, were being considered today by the New York boxing commission. Leonard announced late last night that he was retiring from the ring in deference to the wishes of his mother.

"I am not giving up boxing for

glory or because I can't make the weight but I am retiring for the love of my mother. She is in bad health and I fear that she could not bear the strain if fought again," Leonard said in a long statement.

The retirement of Leonard—the fourth in the history of world's champions—did not cause surprise in boxing circles here.
