

PETITION FOR A MACADAM ROAD

State of Indiana,
County of Adams, SS:
Before the Board of Commissioners of the County of Adams and State of Indiana.

We, the undersigned, and each and all of whom are adult residents, freeholders and voters of Monroe township, Adams county, Indiana, most respectfully petition your honorable body, that you construct and maintain a free macadamized stone road in said Township, over and upon the public highway in said townships on the following route, to-wit:

Commencing on the State Highway at the northeast corner of the incorporated Town of Monroe, in said township and county, thence running south to the south line of said corporation, and thence to terminate all in Monroe township, Adams county. Indiana.

Your petitioners further aver and say that to make said improvement practical and of public utility, that the following approaches onto and leading to the proposed improvement, ought to be drained, graded and macadamized as follows, to-wit:

That the approach from the east at the intersection of Andrews street at the southern end of said highway, be proposed be improved and maintained, graded and improved from said intersection east to the first alley for a distance of about one-hundred thirty feet.

That the approach from the east at the intersection of Andrews street at the southern end of said highway, be proposed be improved and maintained, graded and improved from said intersection east to the first alley for a distance of about four hundred fifty feet.

Your petitioners further aver and say that the improvement prayed for herein is less than three miles in length and connects at each end with an improved macadamized road and wholly within the Township, Adams county, Indiana, and with the exception of the approaches is wholly outside of any incorporated town or city in said county.

Your petitioners further aver and say that the highway and streets herein sought to be improved is a public highway already established and that said roads are public roads, laid out and established in use, and that there is a large amount of public travel over such highway and such streets and that the same will be of public utility to the benefit of all.

Your petitioners further ask that said highway and streets above described be improved to a width of 40 feet, and that said highway above described be graded to a width of 30 feet, and any broken stone be placed thereon to the width of 20 feet, and to a depth of 8 inches at the sides thereof, and to a depth of 12 inches in the center thereof, and that the stone breakers be placed thereon to a depth of four inches upon such broken stone; that said improvement be made a single track and that the name of the same be the "Main Macadamized Road."

That to pay for said improvement we ask that bonds be issued by the County of Adams and State of Indiana, payable in two or three annual installments or series and for the payment of which we ask that a tax be levied upon the taxable property of said Monroe township, in a sufficient amount to pay the interest and principal of said bonds as they become due.

That said improvement be made and constructed and that bonds be issued and paid for the same, upon the taxable property of said Township, including therein the said Town of Monroe, in accordance with the Acts of Legislature of the State of Indiana, passed at the session of 1907, on page 550 and amended in the Acts of 1909, as amended in the Acts of 1909, now in force, provided for the extension of free gravel and macadam roads and all roads and any and all improvements thereto.

We further ask the Board to take all the necessary steps required by law to have said improvement constructed and completed as aforesaid; that the same be constructed without submitting the question of building the same to an election of the voters of said Monroe township, and that the Board construct the same under the laws of the State of Indiana, provided for the extension of free gravel and macadam roads, by Township taxation.

Your petitioners further aver and say that the cost of the improvement herein petitioned for, when added to the total cost for free macadam gravel and public roads in said township, will not exceed two (2) per centum of the total assessed valuation (after deducting all mortgage exemptions) of the property of the Township wherein said road is situated.
