FOUR PERSONS KILLED

Coroner Investigates Fatal Grade Crossing Accident Near Anderson Late Wednesday.

Anderson, Ind., Oct. 8.—Coroner sells of Madison county today investigated the grade crossing accident in which four persons lost their lives near here late yesterday.

An auto driven by David Province, 30, of Mount Summit, was struck by a Pennsylvania passenger train and demolished.

Province, his 75 year old wife, and Mrs. Belle Ramsey, 55, of Middletown, and Mrs. Orpha Emswiller, 60, of Middletown, were the victims.

Bodies of the four were badly mangled and identification was not completed until several hours after the accident. Trainmen worked for more than an hour gathering together the remains of the dead to bring them to Anderson.

The finding of baby clothing in the wrecked auto led to a report that a child had also been killed but was later established that no infant was in the auto at the time of the crash.


