Cubs And White Sox Play 19-Inning Tie

Chicago, Oct. 8.—The Cubs of the National league and the White Sox of the American league started the annual Chicago city series anew today after having battled 19 innings yesterday to a tie, 2 to 2.

The game was called on account of darkness, but not before city series history was made by Grover Cleveland Alexander of the Cubs and Ed Blankenship of the Sox.

Both went the full route, Alexander yielding 20 hits, but he sprinkled them among 19 innings and with brilliant teamwork from his mates, kept out of trouble, while Blankenship yielded but 11 blows.

Yesterday's game was to have been the first of a seven-game series, but it has been sponged off the board as "no contest."

FOUR PERSONS KILLED

Coroner Investigates Fatal Grade Crossing Accident Near Anderson Late Wednesday.

Anderson, Ind., Oct. 8.—Coroner Sells of Madison county today investigated the grade crossing accident in which four persons lost their lives near here late yesterday.

An auto driven by David Province, 30, of Mount Summit, was struck by a Pennsylvania passenger train and demolished.

Province, his 75 year old wife, and Mrs. Belle Ramsey, 55, Middletown, and Mrs. Orpha Emswiler, 60, of Middletown, were the victims.

Bodies of the four were badly mangled and identification was not completed until several hours after the accident. Trainmen worked for more than an hour gathering together the remains of the dead to bring them to Anderson.

The finding of baby clothing in the wrecked auto led to a report that a child had also been killed but it was later established that no infant was in the auto at the time of the crash.
