### Seelye Sets New Record For Non-stop Driving

Auburn, Oct. 23 — The Auburn Automobile company received a telegram late Tuesday afternoon, to the effect that "Cowboy" Seelye, driving an Auburn eight-in-line sedan, completed his endurance drive of six days and nights and six hours, from Indianapolis to Miami, Florida, via New York, arriving in Miami ten minutes behind schedule. He reached Miami at 3:10 p. m. yesterday. "Wild" Bill broke all records for non-stop driving. The speedometer showed 3,469 miles and the running time was 150 hours and 10 minutes. No mechanical trouble of any nature was experienced on the entire trip. Seelye, com-

pletely exhausted, after 150 hours of continuous driving, went to bed immediately after arriving in Miami. He set a new world's record for non-stop driving, his previous world's record, made in an Essex six while driving through northern Indiana a year ago, being 120 hours.
