This spring, I concluded to go in the Adams County Calf Club. My father went to Springfield, Ohio, and bought a fine pure-bred registered calf which cost \$55.00, in which I took much pride and interest, for I wanted to own a fine Jersey cow at the age of sixteen.

On May 1, I started my record and took my calf to a neighbor's house to weigh it. It weighed 140 pounds. During the record period, I fed the 2-3-3-1 ration which consists of corn, oats, bran and oil meal, and from 14 to 16 pounds of skimmed milk. During the month of May it gained fifty pounds and thereafter gained something similar to the first month.

I fed my own calf during the record period and found but very little trouble in caring for it, but I learned not to feed it all the feed and milk it could eat and drink, but to feed it accordingly. The next time I will know how much feed to give it.

New Orleans, La., Oct. 23.—(United Press)—The word "obey" heretofore spoken by brides in the Protestant Episcopal marriage ceremony, has been definitely eliminated by a 66 to 27 vote of the house of bishops of the church.

Although the bishops conceded women the victory in the matter of elimination of the word "obey," they declined to approve the proposal passed by the house of deputies that women might take seats in the lower house.

Count Volpi, head of the mission, and his colleagues were in high spirits as they departed, Volpi declaring to the United Press:

"We have the highest hopes of returning from Washington with a settlement."

The party goes to seek a funding arrangement with the American debt funding commissioners on Italy's debt of around two billion dollars.
