

Freshmen At Western College Win Movie Camera

When the freshman class of Western College was led into chapel by the senior chairman on College Day, the dignity, the grace and the seriousness of manner so impressed one observer that he resolved that such a spectacle should go on record permanently. He at once placed into the hands of President Lloyd, funds for the purchase of a moving picture camera in order that similar interesting and impressive scenes from the college and college life might be kept on permanent record. The donor instructed President Lloyd to turn over the money to the president of the freshman class, and since the freshman class president is not chosen until after the November examinations, President Lloyd entrusted the funds to Miss Josephine Carpenter, who had been chosen cheer leader for the College Day games.

This is a happy omen. Western College has this year taken the first step towards a certain immediate goal. After twelve years of study, President Lloyd, the faculty and the Board of Trustees have come to the unanimous conclusion that Western College shall halt its members permanently to five hundred students. This will keep the college within the range of helpful contact between faculty and student. It is an economic unit, and it will serve to demonstrate this phase of education in America.

This year, then, marks a new epoch. With the opening of the new dormi-

tory, almost two hundred from the long waiting list were admitted to the freshman class. When the two remaining dormitories of the new unit have been completed and a common dining hall built, the quadrangle will then house amply the remaining members of the five hundred. A Music Hall will be forth-coming for Western College has, from the beginning, recognized the necessity of an appreciation of good music in a liberal education. As early as 1913 the college established a fellowship for the creative art—a fellowship which has since that date been held by Dr. Edgar Stillman Kelley, composer of "Pilgrim's Progress."
