U. S. Harbor Defense Is Called Obsolete

Washington, Nov. 24. — (United Press)—Recommendation for the abolishment of Reserve Engineering Training Camps was made in the annual report of Major General Harry Taylor, chief of Army Engineers, submitted to Secretary of War, Davis today.

"While I am greatly in favor of Citizens' Military Training Camps in general," Taylor said, "a thorough study of the Engineer camps has led to the conclusion that these branch camps should be discontinued and it is so recommended. The qualifications of the great majority of men and boys drawn to these camps are not such as

will qualify them for officers of this branch. An overwhelming percentage of them are neither engineers or technical men."

Taylor declares that most of the harbor defense fortifications are now either obsolete or have become relegated to secondary importance due to increase power and range of Naval armaments and the development of aircraft since the World War.

"If these defenses are to be effective," he says, "the power, range, and number of guns, as well as the anti-aircraft defense in these fortifications must keep pace with the development of the Naval armament and aircraft which can be brought against them."

Hold School At Night So Parents Can Attend

Leesburg, Ind., Nov. 24. — (United Press).—In order that the parents of students can come in closer contact with their children and better understand school procedure a novel plan has been adopted here.

At regular intervals during the school year the morning session is abolished and school convenes at 8 o'clock in the afternoon, closing at 8:30 at night.

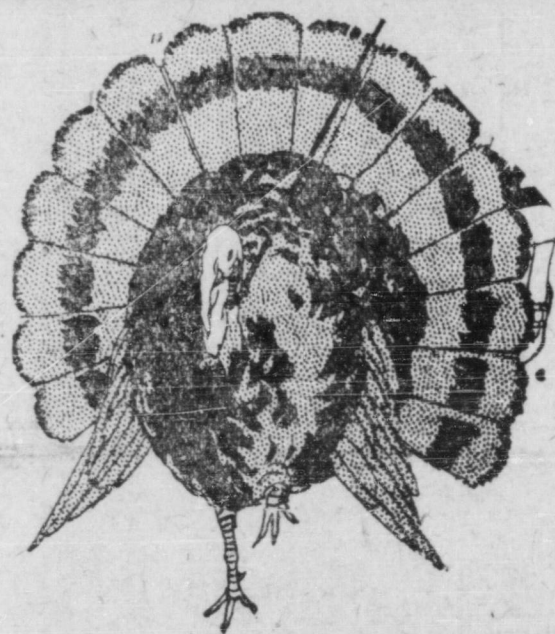
