Two New Insurgents Puzzle G. O. P. Senators

Washington, Dec. 10. — (United Press)—The Republican majority in the senate is deadlocked over what should be done with the two new "baby" insurgents in their ranks, Senator Robert M. La Follette, Jr., and Senator Gerald P. Nye.

Unable to reach a decision, the Republican committee on committees will delay a further meeting until Monday in the hope that some compromise may be reached on whether La Follette should receive the favor of the Republican committee assignments.

In a similar deadlock the senate privileges and elections committee is adjourned until Friday, seeking more light on legality of Nye's appointment by Gov. Serlie, North Dakota.

Muncie Normal To Get New Building Next Year

Indianapolis, Dec. 10. — (United Press)—Construction work on the new assembly hall and library at the Muncie State Normal will start early in the

spring, it was announced today.

Trustees of the Normal at a meeting here decided to award the contract during the first ten days of January.

The sum of \$250,000 was appropriated by the last session of the legislature for the building.

Two Boys Charged With Theft Of Twenty Autos

Hammond, Ind., Dec. 10. — (United Press)—Two lads, both under 18 years of age, are charged here today with the theft of twenty automobiles during the past few weeks.

The boys, Kenneth Robert, 16, and Thomas Evans, 17, have confessed, police said.

Judge Oare Resigns

South Bend, Dec. 10.—Judge Lem Oare, of the St. Joseph county superior court today announced his resignation in a letter addressed to Governor Jackson.

Judge Oare is one of the youngest jurists in the state being 35 years of age.

Man Refuses To Plead Guilty To Manslaughter; Found Guilty Of Murder

East Chicago, Ind., Dec. 10.—(United Press)—William Gilmore was taken to Michigan City today to begin serving a life sentence for the murder of Norman Herbert.

He was convicted in the Porter county court after refusing to enter a plea of guilty to manslaughter as proposed by the state's attorney.

All Harrison County Schools Suspended

Anderson, Ind., Dec. 10. — (United Press)—All of the high schools in Harrison county, Rensselaer High School, and Carthage High School, have been placed on probation until June 1, 1926, by the Indiana High School Athletic association, it became known today.

The action in regard to Harrison county was taken because the schools were said to have played eighth grade students as high school players, and allowed students without proper scholarship credit to participate in games.

Child Killed When Hit By Auto; Driver Held

Indianapolis, Dec. 10. — (United Press)—Eathel McQuillen, 43, was held by police today pending investigation of the death of Catherine Reed, 5, killed when she was struck by McQuillen's automobile.

Three other persons were slightly injured in automobile accidents during the night. One driver sped away after hitting a pedestrian.

Cravens Is Considering Entering Senatorial Race

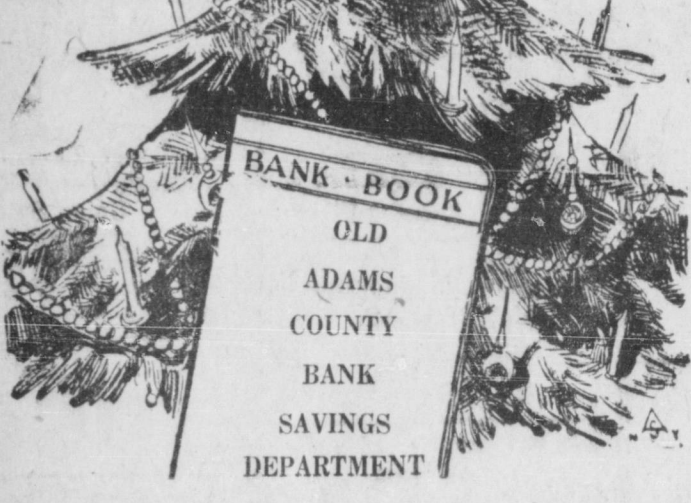
