Names Jury Commissioners  
Judge Jesse C. Sutton today re-appointed Eli W. Johnson and Martin L. Smith to serve as jury commissioners of the Adams circuit court during the next year. The court set December 18 as the date for them to meet at the court house, take the oath, and select the names for the jury box.

**Ford Is Sentenced**  
In the case of the state of Indiana vs. C. B. Ford, the defendant's motion to quash the affidavit was sustained by Judge Sutton. An amended affidavit was filed by the prosecutor and the defendant entered a plea of guilty to the first count and not guilty to the second count. The first count charged public intoxication and the second count charged possession of intoxicating liquor. The court fined Ford \$10 and costs and ordered him committed to the state penal farm until the fine and costs are paid or replevied.
