#### Names Jury Commissioners

Judge Jesse C. Sutton today re-appointed Eli W. Johnson and Martin L. Smith to serve as jury commissioners of the Adams circuit court during the next year. The court set December 18 as the date for them to meet at the court house, take the oath, and select the names for the jury box.

#### Ford Is Sentenced

In the case of the state of Indiana v. C. B. Ford, the defendant's mo-

tion to quash the affidavit was sustained by Judge Sutton. An amended affidavit was filed by the prosecutor and the defendant entered a plea of guilty to the first count and not guilty to the second count. The first count charged public intoxication and the second count charged possession of intoxicating liquor. The court fined Ford \$10 and costs and ordered him committed to the state penal farm until the fine and costs are paid or replevined.

#### NOTICE TO TAXPAYERS OF PROPOSED BOND ISSUE

In the matter of determining to issue bonds by Root Township, in Adams County, Indiana.

Notice is hereby given the taxpayers of Root Township, in Adams County, State of Indiana, that the proper legal officers of said municipality at their meeting held at the school house December 1, 1925, determined to issue bonds or other evidences of indebtedness exceeding five thousand dollars.

The amount of bonds proposed is estimated at \$16,711.90 but not to exceed the sum of \$20,000, bearing interest at the rate of 4 1/4% per annum.

The net assessed value of property in this taxing unit is \$3,491,730.00 and the present indebtedness without this issue is \$8,381.30.

The proceeds of such bond issue are to be used for the cost of construction and expenses incident thereto of the Otto Boerger Road in said unit.

Ten or more taxpayers, other than those who pay poll tax only, will feel themselves aggrieved by such determination may appeal to the State Board of Tax Commissioners for further action by filing a petition therefore with the County Auditor on or before the expiration of twenty-nine days from the 8th day of December, 1925, and the State Board will fix a date for hearing in this county.
