Chicago, Dec. 30.—(United Press)—Wheat dropped sharply in a rush of selling at the opening on the Chicago board of trade today. Corn displayed fractional weakness and oats were inclined toward firmness.

Sellers offered wheat freely, higher Liverpool cables notwithstanding. It was felt the advance of 2 3/4 to 3 cents there was a feeble response to yesterday's upheaval in the local pit.

Pressure in corn came from holders of large lines under the impression that a reaction is in order to bolster the technical position.

Lack of aggressive interest gave oats a steady opening.
