## DAILY REPORT OF LOCAL AND FOREIGN MARKETS

### OPENING GRAIN REVIEW.

Chicago, Feb. 23.—(United Press)—Grain prices opened higher on the Chicago board of trade today.

Higher wheat prices in the Liverpool and Argentine markets, both of which scored price advances this morning, encouraged local dealers and they bought freely of all offerings at the start of the Chicago market. The price advances here ranged from three quarters to two cents.

Corn prices were affected by extremely light receipts only 232 cars being reported as against expectations of 1,000 cars. This gave the corn market some independent strength and prices advanced 1-4 to 1-2 cents.

Oats prices were unchanged to fractionally higher.

Provisions were steady.
