"What I would like to see the Democratic party do in the coming campaign is to get back to true Jeffersonian principles and stand for the things worth while irrespective of whom it hurts and in total disregard of political expediency. We expect a platform of platitudes from the Republican party. Every platform promulgated by that party for years has been weighed and measured, months in advance, with all the accuracy of a pharmacist's scale, by men and women schooled in the wiles of practical politics. Too often in these later years has the Democratic party followed in the wake of these political strategists and presented to an expectant public a colorless reproduction of their offerings. Our cause is too sacred to be bartered and sold in the marts of practical politics. If we are planning today to temporize with passing conditions and "pussy foot" on principles which are fundamental to the perpetuity of American institutions, we shall fail and we ought to fail. I love this quotation, 'Democracy is more than a form of government. It is an ideal. The feeling among the citizens that the government is their government, in which they have a vital interest, is the soul of a democracy.' 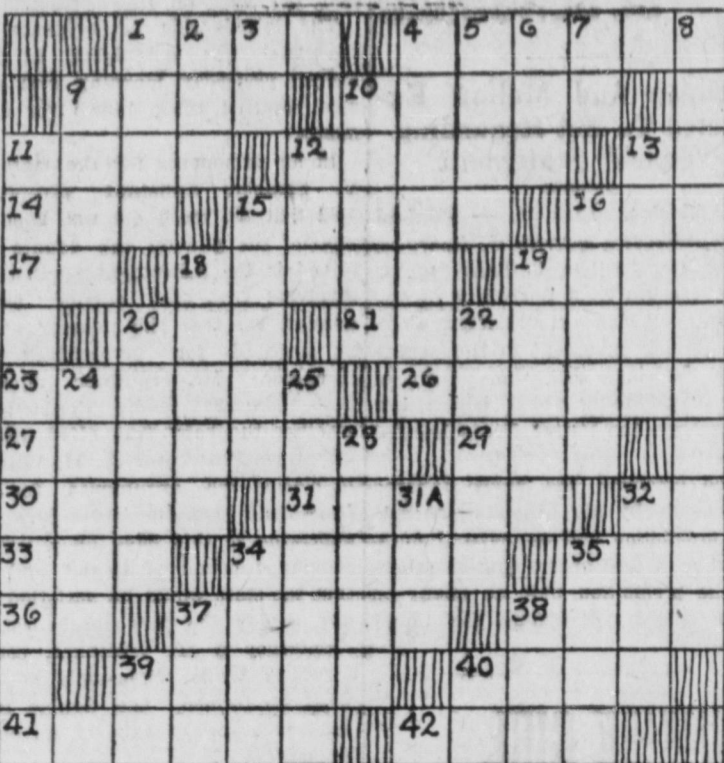

BOARD OF HEALTH NOTICE

NOTICE is hereby given that an order has been issued by the local board of health in compliance with a request from the state board of health that all dogs within the city limits of Decatur be placed under quarantine for a period of ninety days, to aid in preventing further spread of rabies or hydrophobia now prevalent in the state. During the next ninety days therefore the following rules must be complied with:—

First—Quarantine all dogs on the premises of owner or provide efficient muzzling when dogs are not on owner's premises or in leash under control of owner.

Second—Police officers, sheriffs or marshal shall kill all dogs running at large without being muzzled or under control.

Third—Such quarantine and order will be effective until July 15th.
