Senator Means was elected over three other candidates, Carl G. Juneau, Milwaukee; Harvey H. Hanna, Nashville, and Frank B. Dodds Lawrence, Kansas.

The new commander served in the Philippines during the Spanish-American war. As a colonel he led the Argonne in the battle of the Argonne. He has served two years in the senate.
