INDIANA DOCTORS HOLD STATE MEET

State Medical Association Opens 77th Annual Convention

West Baden, Ind., Sept. 22.—(United Press.)—Members of the Indiana State Medical Association are here today for the opening sessions of the seventy-seventh annual convention of the organization.

More than a thousand doctors are expected to attend the three-day meeting which is expected to be one of the outstanding scientific gatherings in the history of medicine.

Business meetings of the state council and the House of Delegates at noon today were to officially open the convention and the annual golf tournament this afternoon was to inaugurate the entertainment program.

Scientific sessions will open tomorrow morning with a general meeting of all delegates, Charles N. Coombs of Terre Haute, president of the association, will deliver his address at that time.

The principal speaker at the general scientific session will be Dr. Ernst Loewenstein of Vienna, Austria, one of the foreign delegates to the meeting of the International Union against Tuberculosis. He will speak on "Some Phases of Tuberculosis."

Many of Indiana's leading specialists will address the body during the course of the convention on their various subjects and the scientific program is believed to be one of the best ever arranged for the state association.

The feature of the entertainment program will be the annual banquet Thursday evening at the West Baden Springs hotel. Dr. Edwin P. Morrow, former governor of Kentucky will be the principal speaker at that time.

Purdue Swine Day To Be Held October 1

Lafayette, Ind., Sept. 22.—(United Press.)—Many problems of the swine feeders in Indiana will be discussed at the sixth annual "Swine Day" which will be held Friday, October 1 at Purdue University. Several hundred farmers and swine men are expected for the meeting.

Twenty lots of experimental hogs will be inspected and opportunity will be offered for visitors to obtain full information on the feeding results. Comparisons of tankage and methods of feeding tankage are included in the experiments. Eight lots of experimental hogs are being used to compare mineral mixtures. Inspection of the experimental hogs will start at 10:00 a. m. on the Experiment Station Swine Farm three miles north of West Lafayette.

Prof. F. B. Morrison of the University of Wisconsin will talk on "New Swine Feeding Facts". Prof. Morrison's discussion will be of unusual interest to farmers and swine growers. The meeting is free and will hold something of interest for every farmer who feeds hogs.

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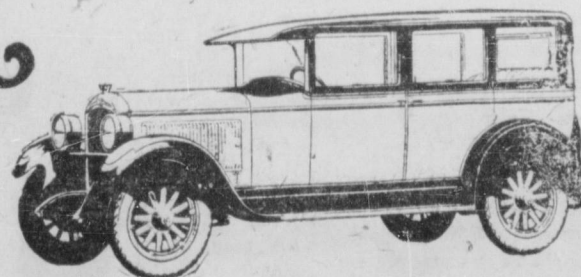
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
