State To Reforest Old Coal And Shale Lands

Indianapolis, Ind., Jan. 7—(United Press)—Reforestation of abandoned coal and shale lands is to be undertaken by the Indiana State Conservation commission in cooperation with Superintendent John Megenhardt, of the Big Ben Coal company, of Center Point, Indiana.

The first experiment will be the planting of ten acres of the company's abandoned land with native trees.

Megenhardt has agreed to purchase 12,000 trees from the conservation department, according to Director Richard Lieber. Planting will be done by employees of the mine operator and under the supervision of the state foresters. Trees will come from the state nursery operated in connection with the Clarke County State Forest Reserve and Experimental station.

Species selected include white pine, American red pine, Australian pine, yellow poplars and a number of native hardwoods that are rapid growers.
