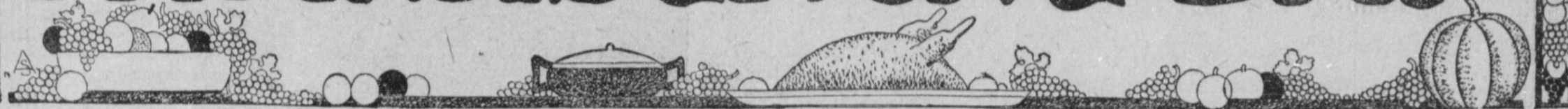

With these, and with a well worn pair of big overalls secured before he started the trip from a janitor at the PRO Studios, the actor had a foundation

for a costume which turned out to be a marvel of accuracy.

Auto Fatalities Decrease

Indianapolis, Ind., Nov. 22.—(INS)—Automobile fatalities in this city during the year ending Nov. 7, according to United States Department of Commerce figures, decreased to 67 from the 1926 toll of 86.

Only 10 of the 67 fatalities this year were children, a decrease over last year. The decrease was believed due largely to a safety campaign which has been carried on by city officials.

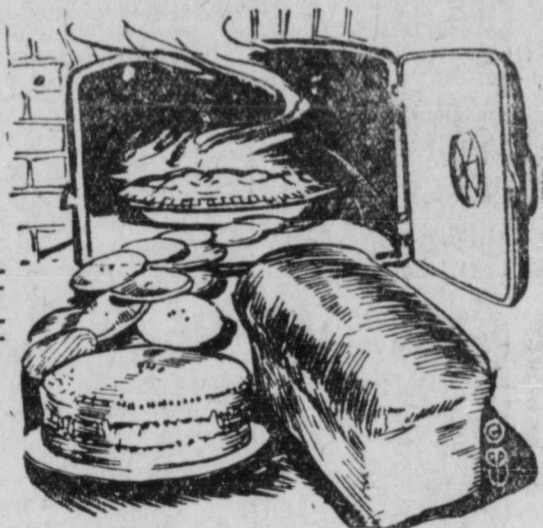
Indianapolis Gets Factory

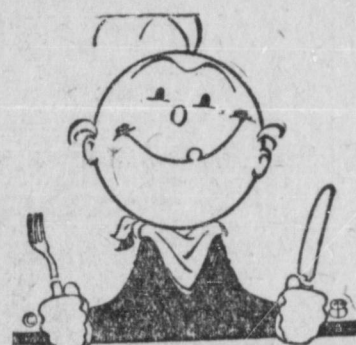
