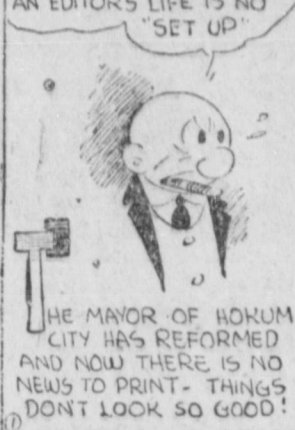

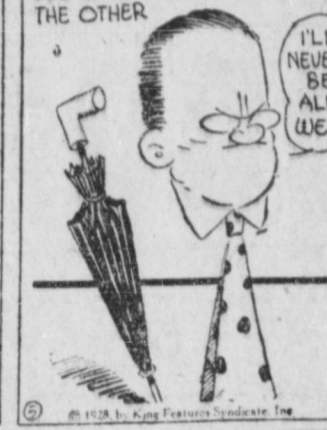

Your petitioners further ask that said highway above described be improved, graded and that broken stone be placed upon the grade and that upon such broken stone there be placed stone screenings.
