

POLICE UNCOVER
KIDNAPING PLOT

Chicago, April 9—(UPI)—An extensive kidnaping plot in which more than a dozen wealthy Chicagoans were to have been abducted and held for ransom has been revealed by the rescue of Thomas Gaynor and the arrest of seven members of an abduction gang, police announced today.

Police said the kidnapers planned to demand ransom totalling nearly \$1,000,000 from gamblers and others by duplacting the operations carried on by three of their number in Decatur.

Gaynor, wealthy automobile and hotel man, is recovering from the effects of lying for two days in a cold, damp cottage near Crystal Lake, Ill., his eyes taped shut. He was threatened with death if the \$100,000 ransom demanded for his release was not paid.
