

**ROBINSON, STUMP
WIN NOMINATION
FOR U. S. SENATOR**

in the victory of United States Senator James E. Watson, over Secretary of Commerce Herbert Hoover, in presidential primary yesterday, Oscar Indiana's Republican presidential candidate, this afternoon declared that, in view of Hoover's large popular vote in Indiana, it was Senator Watson's "moral duty to permit Indiana's 33 delegates to the national convention to go to Hoover after Watson was eliminated from the consideration."

Watson Has 25,000 Lead

Indianapolis, May 9—Returns from 2,720 out of the 3,610 precincts in the state gave for president; Republican James E. Watson, 155,837; Herbert Hoover, 130,605. Democrat, Evans Woolen, 89,919.

For senator Robinson, Republican had 149,377 votes and Stump, Democrat, had 93,964 votes.
