Coroner F. C. Krest who examined the body declared that the little victim had been criminally attacked, and death was due to strangulation.

As police began the hunt for the murderer, headquarters communicated with Youngstown, where a two week's search for ten-year-old Beatrice Rosenbaum ended Sunday with the finding of her body in a wooded ravine.

The Youngstown girl had been enticed from her home, according to police, and taken away in an auto which was also described as "a small dark sedan."
