Peters Issues Statement On Return From Houston

Indianapolis, July 2—(INS) More than two-thirds of the Indiana delegates to the Democratic National convention were "openly favorable to the candidacy of Gov. Smith as second choice after Evans Woollen," R. Earl Peters Democratic state chairman, said in a statement issued here today upon his return from Houston Texas.

Peters said that telegrams and letters received by the delegates from Indiana convinced him that the Democratic presidential nominee is held in high favor in Indiana.



Funeral arrangements have not yet been made.


