

## STATE TO PAVE MORE HIGHWAYS

Indianapolis, Aug. 2.—(U.P.)—Bids on miles of state roads, will be received by the state highway commission by August 14, swelling projects under contract this year to 253 miles, or 34 miles more than ever put under contract by the commission in a single year.

The sealed proposals will be opened in the office of John D. Williams, director, at 10 a. m. (est) August 14. It will be the department's fifth road for the 1928 construction year.

Included in the projects involved, described by William J. Titus, chief engineer, are:

State road 6, from Missouri street to E. Gary to Westerville, 22 miles.

Porter and Laporte counties.

U. S. road 24 from Logansport to U. S. road 24 in Cass and Miami counties. This will be a relocation of the entire distance and therefore not a new road.

Distance between two cities will be shortened by the relocation.

U. S. road 24, from Peru to Wabash, 13 miles in Miami and Wabash counties. Nearly all of this is on relocation and shortens the distance between these cities about three miles.

State road 15, from Milford to New Paris, 8 miles in Kosciusko and Elkhart counties. This also is on relocation and will eliminate two crossings of the Big Four railroad and an adjacent interurban crossing.

State road 19, from Nappanee north

for 8 miles, to connect with pavement to Elkhart, in Elkhart county.

Clinton, Ind., Aug. 2.—(U.P.)—Robert Rhoads, 18, of Paris, Ill., was at the point of death in the Vermillion County hospital here today with a broken neck received when he dived into the Happyland swimming pool here. He is paralyzed from the shoulders down.

Young Rhoads is the pitcher for the Paris Keystones which team is scheduled to play here next Sunday.

The youth made the dive into the shallow water on a dare.

## Steps Taken To Straighten Creek In Van Wert, Ohio

Van Wert, Ohio, Aug. 2.—The Town creek improvement project will begin early next fall under plans calling for straightening and cleaning the stream's channel to allow water to flow out of the city more rapidly.

This action was assured Monday afternoon when the board of county commissioners approved the amended report of T. K. Priddy, county surveyor with a new set of schedules and estimated assessments for the project.

In accordance with changes ordered by the commissioners in session June 22. That order was based on application of B. C. Pearson asking for change in the nature and extent of the proposed work.

The time for letting the contract for the improvement of the creek has been set at 12 o'clock noon August 30.

The reports of the county surveyor, as approved, provides that the improvement begin at the west line of the Willow Bend Golf course and ter-

minate at the Hattery road about one mile east of the Van Wert-Paulding road in Hoaglin township. It is estimated that the improvement will cost \$40,037.33.

Repainting runs from \$10 to \$25. Taking dents out of body panels and doors runs from \$3 to \$16 for labor. A fender can be replaced for a labor charge of \$1 to \$2.50. The cost of fenders runs from \$3.50 to \$5.
