ordered the county board of review to place a 30 per cent increase on improvements in Berne.

The county board of review refused to comply with the recommendations and rejected the entire order. The increases first ordered would have increased the valuations in this county approximately \$1,100,000. The net valuations in the county, after deducting mortgage exemptions, totaled \$32,911,210. With the increases ordered today the valuations will be increased \$690,048, making a total of \$33,601,258. The valuations last year was \$35,902,770.
