**TUBERCULIN TEST  
IS PROGRESSING**

**Total Of 8,107 Cattle Tested  
In Seven Townships Of  
Adams County**

A total of 8,107 head of cattle have been Tuberculin tested in Adams county, according to a report made to the county agent, Fred Christen, by Jay B. Current, federal veterinarian who is in charge of the work. Dr. Current has tested seven of the twelve townships in Adams county, which represent half the total area of square miles in the county.

The townships in which the T. B. test has been completed are, Jefferson, Blue Creek, St. Marys, Union, Preble, Kirkland and French. Dr. Current is now testing in Hartford township and expects to have that township completed within the next two weeks. He will then take the remaining townships in the following order: Wabash, Monroe, Washington and Root.

The 8,107 head of cattle tested represents the number of animals from 1,005 farms, or an average of 8 cows
