NOTICE TO TAXPAYERS

Notice is hereby given that on November 3, 1930, will be the last day to pay your fall installment of taxes. The county treasurer's office will be open from 8 A. M. to 4 P. M. during the month of November. All taxes not paid by that time will become delinquent and a 10% penalty will be added. Those who have bought or sold property and wish a change of address, are asked to come in at once.

Call on the Auditor for errors and any reductions. The Treasurer can make no corrections.

The Treasurer will not be responsible for the penalty of delinquent taxes resulting from the omission of tax-payer to state definitely on what property they desire to pay. In whose name it may be found, in whose township or corporation it is situated.

Persons owing delinquent taxes should pay them at once, the law is such that there is no option left for the tax-payer but to pay the collection of delinquent taxes.

The annual sale of delinquent lands and lots will take place on the second Monday in February 1931 at 9:30 A. M.

County orders will not be paid to anyone owing delinquent taxes. All persons are warned against them. All receipts will be held after expiration of time as the new depositary law requires the Treasurer to make daily deposits.

Particular attention: If you pay taxes in more than one township, you must pay in each township. It is also to be noted that your receipt's call for all your real estate and personal property.

In making inquiries of the treasurer regarding taxes to insure that you do not fail to include return postage.
