any reductions the Treasurer can
make will correct the same.

The Treasurer will not be responsi-
ble for the penalty of delinquent
taxes resulting from the omission
of tax payment. State definitely

what township or corporation it is
situated.

Persons owing delinquent taxes
should pay them at once. The law is
such that there is no option left for
the treasurer but enforce the collec-
tion of delinquent taxes.

The annual audit of delinquent
lands and lots will take place on the
second Monday in February 1931 at
10:30 A. M.

Orders will not be paid to
anyone owing delinquent taxes.
All persons are warned against them.

No receipts will be held after ex-
piration of time, as the new deposi-
tions to the treasurer to pay the
treasurer daily deposits.

Particular attention: If you pay
taxes in more than one township
mention the fact to the treasurer
so that your receipts will be
all your real estate and personal prop-
erty.


